## Upgrading the Pacific Highway

### Karuah to Bulahdelah sections 2 & 3

*This project is jointly funded by the Federal and New South Wales governments*

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority has engaged Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd to design, construct and maintain for ten years the 23km Pacific Highway upgrade from Karuah to Bulahdelah sections two and three.

#### **Construction update – May 2009 to July 2009.**

- Two-way traffic is now using the new concrete pavement over the full length of the project.
- Completion of bulk earthworks activities in the central and northern sections of the project.
- Placement and bitumen sealing of the select material layer (underneath the concrete).
- Commencement of the final layer of base concrete paving from the southern end of the project.
- Commencement of the first layer of sub-base concrete paving in the central and northern sections of the project.
- Installation of arch units and retaining wall construction at Jacks Creek and Myall Lakes fauna underpass.
- Installation of 30m long pre-cast super-tee girders and construction of bridge deck at Houstons Flat bridge.

#### **Traffic conditions**

Traffic delays will be experienced at times along the highway due to blasting and construction activities. Where necessary, changes to traffic conditions and speed limits will be implemented for traffic safety along sections of the project as the works progress.
