Upgrading the Pacific Highway Karuah to Bulahdelah sections 2 & 3

This project is jointly funded by the Australian and New South Wales governments

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority has engaged Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd to design, construct and maintain the 23km Pacific Highway from Karuah to Bulahdelah sections two and three upgrade for ten years.

Construction update – May to July 2007

Construction works have commenced or will occur in the following areas:

- Browns Flat to Waterholes Gap.
- Nerong to Burdekins Gap.
- Houston's bridge site.
- Jacks Creek and Nerong vicinity.

Activities will include:

- Installation of fencing and vegetation clearing.
- Installation of environmental controls.
- Earthworks and foundation works.
- Bridge preparatory and foundation works.

Changes to traffic conditions

Overtaking lanes will be shortened in some areas to provide safe access points to the construction site.

Some delays may be experienced along the highway due to construction work.

Safety

Motorists and pedestrians are advised to observe all project signs and traffic control directions.

Construction hours

Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm.
Nearby residents will be advised of any construction works to occur outside normal working hours.
