Upgrading the Pacific Highway Karuah to Bulahdelah sections 2 & 3

This project is jointly funded by the Australian and New South Wales governments

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority has engaged Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd to design, construct and maintain the 23km Pacific Highway upgrade from Karuah to Bulahdelah sections two and three for ten years.

Construction update – February to April 2008

- Continuing earthworks over the full length of the project with controlled blasting to continue at Burdekin's Gap and Nerong north and south cuttings.
- Multiple crushing and screening operations are in progress to produce select fill and drainage rock.
- Continuing bridge works at all seven sites along the project.
- Concrete paving will commence south of Nerong in March 2008.

Traffic conditions

Traffic delays will be experienced at times along the highway due to blasting and construction activities. Changes to traffic conditions and speed limits will be implemented for traffic safety where necessary.

Safety

Motorists and pedestrians are advised to observe all project signage and traffic control directions during construction.

Construction hours

Monday to Friday 6:30am to 7pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm. Nearby residents will be advised of any construction works occurring outside normal working hours.
