



Upgrading the Pacific Highway Karuah to Bulahdelah sections 2 & 3

*This project is jointly funded by the Federal and
New South Wales governments*

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority has engaged Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd to design, construct and maintain the 23km Pacific Highway upgrade from Karuah to Bulahdelah sections two and three for ten years.

Construction update – February 2009 to April 2009.

Two way traffic now using:

- The 13km section of new concrete pavement south of Jacks Creek.
- The 8km section of new concrete pavement from Grey Gum Gully to the northern end of the project.
- Two way traffic will be switched onto the 2km of new concrete pavement from Jacks Creek to Grey Gum Gully (adjacent the township of Nerong) in the week commencing 23 February 2009 (weather permitting).
- Reconstruction of the old sections of highway including, bulk earthworks, drainage and bridge construction will be undertaken to form the second carriageway of the new highway (stage 2 earthworks).
- Commencement of concrete paving for the new northbound carriageway as sections of earthworks are completed.

Traffic conditions

Traffic delays will be experienced at times along the highway due to blasting and construction activities. Where necessary, changes to traffic conditions and speed limits will be implemented for traffic safety along sections of the project as the works progress.
