Upgrading the Pacific Highway

Karuah to Bulahdelah sections 2 & 3

This project is jointly funded by the Australian and New South Wales governments

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority has engaged Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd to design, construct and maintain for ten years the 23km Pacific Highway Karuah and Bulahdelah sections two and three upgrade project.

Construction update – February to April 2007

Initial construction works will commence along the route approximately 1km south of Viney Creek Road West and end just south of Booral Road, approximately 3km south of Bulahdelah. The initial works will include:

- Establishment of Abigroup site office compound.
- Fencing of corridor.
- Minor utility adjustments including power and phone.
- Installation of environmental control devices.
- Vegetation clearing and other preparatory works.

Changes to traffic conditions

The northbound overtaking lane south of Nerong will be shortened to provide safe access to the construction site offices.

Safety

Motorists and pedestrians are advised to observe all project signage and traffic control directions.

Construction hours

Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm

Nearby residents will be advised of any construction works to occur outside normal working hours.
